
Ein wenig Geschichte ... 150 Jahre Erfahrung

- 2012 Revision der Swiss Rules of International Arbitration



Sprache SCAI Fälle (2004 - 2019)





Herkunft der Parteien (2019)




2004 – 2019 aus 120 Ländern

Märkte (2016 - 2019)





Verfahrensart (2019)




Schnelligkeit & Qualität

Durchschnittsdauer:

- Emergency Relief: 15 Tage
- Expedited Procedure: 6 Mt und 13 Tage
- Ordinary procedure: 11 Mr
- Beschwerdeverfahren BGer: 6 Mt

Sometimes followed by setting aside procedures and execution requests at State Courts

MODEL ARBITRATION CLAUSE

Any dispute, controversy, or claim arising out of, or in relation to, this contract, including the validity, invalidity, breach, or termination thereof, shall be resolved by arbitration in accordance with the Swiss Rules of International Arbitration of the Swiss Chambers' Arbitration Institution in force on the date on which the Notice of Arbitration is submitted in accordance with these Rules.

The number of arbitrators shall be ... ("one", "three", "one or three");


The seat of the arbitration shall be ... (name of city in Switzerland, unless the parties agree on a city in another country);

The arbitral proceedings shall be conducted in (insert desired language).

The parties may agree at any time to submit the dispute to mediation in accordance with the Swiss Rules of Mediation of the Swiss Chambers' Arbitration Institution.
